This Distribution Agreement (“Agreement”) is entered into as of _____

Together,
Distributor and Supplier are referred to herein as the “Parties” and each individually as a
 “Party.”

The Parties agree that Supplier has contributed source code (the “Supplier’s Code”) for
the open source software known as “Pharo” (the “Software”), and that Supplier retains all
rights in and to Supplier’s Code, aside from the rights expressly granted to Distributor in
this Agreement. The Parties acknowledge that the Software in its entirety is a collective
work containing source code contributions from several authors, and that Supplier’s Code
is only a small component part of the Software work as a whole.

Supplier hereby grants Distributor a perpetual, irrevocable, non-exclusive, royalty-free,
worldwide license to distribute the Software, and specifically the Supplier’s Code therein,
to end users, subject to the license agreement commonly known as the “MIT License”
which is
